Topic: Fabulous Farming	Learning Opportunities		
Physical Being active, coordination, control and movement, making healthy choices.	Use scissors to cut out different farm animal pictures. You could print some or look in newspapers/magazines.	Make some bread like the Little Red Hen. Take a photo of what you have made. 	Go on a bike/scooter ride around a park. Collect items to create a collage of things you see.
Literacy, Communication and Language Speaking and listening, language and literacy.	Go to the library and find an information book about farms. What facts can you learn?	Go on a walk; how many things can you find that start with the letters in your name. Take photos.	Do you know any animal stories? What's your favourite? Mathematics Counting, understanding and using numbers, calculation, Shapes and measures.	Make an animal picture using 2D shapes e.g. circle, square, triangle, rectangle, diamond.	Learn an animal counting song to perform to the class. Eg 5 speckled frogs or 5 little ducks. 	How many numbers can you find near where you live? Can you find numbers over 10? Take photos.
Understanding the World People, places, the world, community, technology and the environment.	Find out 3 facts about your favourite farm animal.	Find out about a festival people celebrate. Try looking on Cbeebies. www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/let'scelebrate/watch	Go on nature walk. Take photos or draw some pictures of things you find.
Expressive Arts and Design Art, music, movement, dance, role-play and design and technology	Learn a new nursery rhyme and make up some actions for it. 	Design a mask of your favourite character from the Little Red Hen Story.	Can you think of actions for all the animals in the Little Red Hen? Use them to retell the story to someone.
