Communication

- Create and solve seaside riddles.
- Read and explore a range of information texts before writing our own.
- Write postcards using different sentence types.
- Continue to work on our presentation, handwriting and SPAG.
- Use drama to explore and act out Grace Darling's life.

Creative

- Explore colour mixing and applying this in artwork.
- Create a shell using clay.
- Use instruments and our voices to create seaside shanties and tunes.
- Perform dances to seaside music.
- Work together in team games such as volley ball.

Knowledge and understanding

- Explore animals at the seaside and their habitats.
- Learn about significant events and people beyond living memory.
- Compare and evaluate how the seaside has changed.
- Explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive.
