## Creative

We will be immersing ourselves in Shakespeare's plays and carrying out lots of creative activities:

- Creating a sewn tableau to represent a scene from Macbeth
- Exploring costume design
- Composing soundtracks
- Acting in role as Shakespeare's characters

## Knowledge and understanding

We will be investigating many questions inspired by William Shakespeare's life and work:

- Were there cures for the plague?
- What does it mean to be historically significant?
- Where is Stratford-Upon-Avon? What is it like there?
- How does light travel?
- How is light used in theatres?
- Can I use programming to control a light?

## Communication

**Writing** → biographies, stories, newspapers, diaries and speeches

**Reading** → adaptations of Shakespeare's plays and some of his original work

**Exploring** → themes in his plays such as conflict, loyalty, honesty and love

**Questioning** → using the plays as a starting point to ask thoughtful and challenging questions
