<b>Literacy &amp; Communication</b>	Write a non-chronological report about the different seas - don't forget to illustrate it. (2pages)	Write a play based on Sinbad and his travels.	Find a picture book or story that is about the water. Create a comic strip of the text.	Imagine that all the water has dried up on the planet. Write a newspaper report about it. (2 pages) Remember to use the 5 Ws: What? Where? When? Who? Why?
<b>Maths &amp; Problem Solving</b>	Can you write in digital, analogue and written form, different times of the day that you use water? Can you calculate how many minutes, hours and days you use water for in a week? 	Find out the different capacities of bottles in your house? Can you convert these into litres and millilitres? 	Find out the perimeter of your sink, bath and shower? You could also find out the perimeter of your fish tank if you have one. 😊	Children to complete a blue abyss maths worksheet (Ask Mrs Adeyemo or Mr Silk for this)
<b>Science and the Outside environment</b>	Find out about how the water cycle works and find a creative way to display this.	Find out about different seas of the world and animals that live in them. Create a poster to display this.	Create a set of 10 top trump cards about famous explorers - be prepared to play!	Find out about the environmental factors that are currently affecting the earth. Think about how the world currently is and how this could change in the future. Draw and write about the changes and how these could be prevented. Think about: Animals, buildings, monuments, trees and other natural features.
<b>Humanities &amp; Citizenship</b>	Find out about a famous explorer.  Write an autobiography about your life. (At least one page)	Find out about music that is influenced about the sea or water. Can you create your own?	Ships have been important in history and are still important in modern times. Produce a fact sheet about them. (At least 1 page)	Draw and label the seas of the world.
<b>Creative Arts</b>	Create a rap about the water cycle. Write it down and perform it to the class. 	Build a replica of a map of the world labelling the seas. Be as creative as you like.	Create different instruments that use water.	Design and create a piece of jewellery or clothing based on the sea.
