

Create a graph comparing the size of armies between different nations. 	Design and make a war and peace game using facts you know.
Science and the Outside environment (Science, PE, Healthy lifestyles, Eco issues and investigation)	Design a parachute for a soldier and test how long it takes for it to fall to the ground. How can you improve the parachute to make the soldier fall slower?	Acts of kindness- challenge yourself to complete an act of kindness each day- keep a log of what you have done. 	How could you be more self sufficient and take care of the environment. Create a poster sharing your ideas	 Investigate the question 'Were people healthier during World War 2 or now?'
Humanities and Citizenship (RE, History, Geography, Moral & Social and Economic Awareness)	Research the different symbols of peace and why they are used.	Research a war that you are interested in- create a time line of events that took place during that time.	What does peace mean to you? Have somebody film you or be prepared to share your thoughts with the rest of the class.	Visit a museum and find out what information they have about different wars- take photos and write about your trip.
Creative Arts (Art, Design & technology, Music, Drama & Dance)	 Create a picture (using paint, collage or drawing) to show the contrast between war and peace.	Write some lyrics to a song encouraging peace in the world.	Create a propaganda poster encouraging people to join the army. 	Make an air raid shelter-think about what materials would be the best to use.
