<p>Literacy</p>	<p><u>Acrostic Poem</u> <i>Choose a word linked to winter e.g. snowflake, snowman and write a sentence or a word that begins with the letter on each line.</i></p> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center;"> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-right: 10px;"> S N O W M A N </div>  </div>	<p><u>Story</u> <i>Write a story linked to winter. You could use one of our class texts as a model. Think about who your characters are and where it is set. This could be written on paper or on the blog. If you feel really creative you could make a book!</i></p>	<p><u>Descriptive piece</u> <i>Use your sense (smell, see, hear, touch) to describe something linked to winter.</i></p> 
<p>Maths</p>	<p><u>Symmetrical snowflake</u> <i>Use the image below or create your own symmetrical snowflake. Remember that it has to be the same on each side! You can colour and decorate your snowflake if you wish.</i></p>	<p><u>Heads and feet</u> <i>Use this link (http://nrich.maths.org/924) to find a maths problem. You need to work out how many hens and sheep there are. Once you have finished, create your own problem.</i></p> 	<p><u>Baking</u> <i>Follow instructions or a recipe to make a winter treat.
